Please read this material carefully, make every effort to meet each deadline, and email Kecia Hayman at the address below if you have any questions.

Note: Every school is expected to nominate students.

- Avoid scheduling school performances that will conflict with Honors Chorus rehearsal and performance schedules.
- Schedule auditions early enough to avoid conflicts with other school activities. Your school nomination list, registration forms, and permission slips for all nominated students must reach Ms. Kecia Hayman, Honors Chorus Manager, at Lake Seneca Elementary School, 13600 Wanegarden Drive, Germantown, MD, 20874, by November 19, 2014, or the places reserved for your school will be given to another school.
- Be sure to use the audition procedures and rating sheet to insure that students you nominate sing with head voice, are able to match pitch, maintain a harmony part, will attend regularly and participate responsibly.
- Please e-mail Ms. Kecia Hayman at Kecia_L_Hayman@mcpsmd.org as soon as possible if you learn that a child you nominated will not participate.
- Please help organize car pools and see that all chorus members from you school have each other's phone numbers.
- We need your help in encouraging excellent advanced piano students to audition as student accompanists.

Chorus Description

The Elementary Honors Choruses were established in 1982 to bring talented children of various backgrounds together to study and perform choral music representing a wide variety of historical eras and cultures and to achieve the following objectives:

- To provide a high-level performance opportunity for fifth grade students with outstanding choral singing ability.
- To help students develop and refine choral singing skills and enhance their ability to read music.
- To reinforce Curriculum Framework objectives for the elementary general music program.
- To bring talented children of various backgrounds together to study and perform choral music representing a wide variety of historical eras and cultures.
- To strengthen the choral program in MCPS elementary schools by providing opportunities for teachers to observe exemplary choral teaching techniques.

Instructions for Audition and Selection

- 1. For purposes of the Elementary Honors Choruses, the county has been divided into two geographic districts. The attached list indicates the number of students you may send from your school based on approximately 4 percent of the projected number of students in the highest grade (5 or 6). This will result in a chorus which numbers approximately 220 students.
- 2. The audition is designed to obtain a variety of information about each student. Only those students who demonstrate accuracy of pitch, ability to maintain a harmony part and use of head voice should be nominated for the Honors Chorus.

- 3. Please evaluate the data recorded on the audition score sheet in order to make final determination of the students your school will send. Keep the completed audition score sheet. We realize that decisions are difficult since so few children are eligible. Please use your best judgment.
- 4. After completing auditions and making your selections (October 22, 2014, at the latest), give a permission slip to each student you are nominating, asking for its return within three school days. When all have been returned, please forward them to Ms. Kecia Hayman at Lake Seneca Elementary School, 13600 Wanegarden Drive, Germantown, MD, 20874, together with the list of nominated students. The deadline for receipt of these items is November 19, 2014. In the event that a school does not nominate the number of students for which it is eligible, or if the permission slips are not returned by the deadline, those positions will be redistributed to another school.
- 5. On November 19, 2014, the honors chorus managers will begin to create extensive databases rosters, and nametags, therefore no additional student names will be accepted after this date (except for additional spots as determined by the management).

ELEMENTARY HONORS CHORUS AUDITION

<u>Instructions:</u> Record points earned in each category on the Audition Score Sheet using the scoring rubrics provided. Consider recording auditions to allow for further reflection. In addition, this may provide parents with insight into your decision, should they question your judgment.

I. Range: Student is able to vocalize all pitches in exercise below.

Repeat pattern on the following beginning pitches.



Scoring - Yes = 4 points No = 0 points

- **II.** <u>Ability to sing on pitch:</u> Student sings "Happy Birthday" (unaccompanied) maintaining pitch accuracy. *Teacher should play tonic triad* (*G*, *B*, *D*) *and beginning pitch* (*D*) *ONLY*.
- Scoring 4 Completely accurate
 - 3 Very few mistakes
 - 2 Inaccurate
 - 0 Unable to maintain pitch

III. Aural Memory (Ability to learn music quickly):

RHYTHM: Student echo-claps the following patterns clapped by the teacher; one hearing only, one try only. Score each example separately.



This example is to establish the procedure. DO NOT SCORE THIS EXAMPLE.






Scoring -

MELODY: Student echo-sings, on "loo," the following patterns played on the piano; one hearing only, one try only. Score each example separately.



If student's score on part III is <u>18 or higher</u>, then proceed to part IV. If not, child is ineligible for Honors Chorus.

IV. Ability to maintain harmony part: Student sings ostinato below as teacher sings the melody of "Hey, Ho! Nobody Home." Student should be able to maintain the ostinato with pitch and rhythm accuracy.



Total the student's points to obtain his/her score.

Your child is eligible to audition for membership in the 2015 Elementary Honors Chorus. The Honors Chorus was formed in 1982 by the MCPS Department of Curriculum and Instruction to bring together talented children of various backgrounds to study and perform choral music representing a wide variety of historical eras and cultures and to achieve the following objectives:

- To provide a challenging performance opportunity for elementary students in the highest grade (5 or 6) with outstanding singing ability.
- To help students develop and refine choral singing skills and enhance their ability to read music.
- To reinforce the curriculum framework objectives for the elementary schools by providing opportunities for teachers to observe exemplary choral teaching techniques.

The audition is designed to obtain a variety of information about each student. The audition will be administered to all interested students during the school day by their school general/choral music teachers.

Rehearsals will be held on Wednesday evenings from 7:15–8:45 p.m., at Martin Luther King, Jr. Middle School, 13737 Wisteria Drive, Germantown, Maryland 20874. Rehearsals will begin on February 11, 2015. The concert will be held on May 13, 2015, at Watkins Mill High School. Attendance at all rehearsals is expected. Participants are responsible for providing their own transportation.

Student Accompanists

The Elementary Honors Chorus presents opportunities for qualified students to participate as student accompanists. One or two advanced pianists will be selected to accompany one selection performed by the chorus and possibly to perform a solo as well. Please make the following information known to all students whom you believe to be interested and qualified:

Qualifications:

- a. The student should be currently enrolled in Grade 5 (or in Grade 6 in a school which includes sixth grade).
- b. The student should be unusually musical, well past intermediate level and able to demonstrate the ability to accompany standard octavo music for treble chorus.

Auditions:

- a. Auditions will be held on the evening of **Thursday**, **January 8**, **2015**. Appointments should be made by the student's parent/guardian by calling the music secretary at 301-279-3250, **no later than December 2**, **2014**.
- b. Students will be asked to perform two solo compositions of their choice for a selection committee composed of the North and South County conductors, accompanists, Honors Chorus Managers and the General/Choral Music Coordinator. It is not necessary to memorize these selections.
- c. Students will be mailed a copy of a choral accompaniment to be practiced at home and played at the audition. It is not necessary to memorize this.

Dear Parent:

CONGRATULATIONS! Your child has been chosen by the elementary general music teacher to be a representative from your school to the 2015 North County Elementary Honors Chorus. This selection was made through audition on the basis of his/her demonstrated musical ability. Only a few students from each school have been selected to participate in this exciting choral experience.

Rehearsals will be held every Wednesday evening from 7:15–8:45 p.m. at Martin Luther King, Jr. Middle School, 13737 Wisteria Drive, Germantown, Maryland 20874. Please mark your calendar with the rehearsal and performance dates listed on the next page.

Students are expected to attend all rehearsals as well as the concert. Students are allowed three absences. A fourth absence, however, will result in loss of chorus membership and the student will not be eligible to perform in the concert. Attendance at the final rehearsal on May 6, 2015, is <u>mandatory</u>. Any student absent from rehearsal will not be permitted to participate in the concert. Chorus members are expected to follow adult directions during rehearsals. Failure to do so may result in dismissal from the chorus. Participants are responsible for their own transportation. Parents are encouraged to arrange carpools. Please contact the music teacher if assistance is needed.

We believe that children with outstanding musical abilities should be recognized and provided with opportunities to expand their musical potential. You and your child should feel a great sense of pride in his/her selection for the Elementary Honors Chorus. Because membership in the Elementary Honors Chorus involves a major commitment of time for the rehearsals and performance, we recommend that you and your child discuss this responsibility before accepting the nomination.

The registration fee is \$20.00. This fee is non-refundable. This program is entirely funded by participant fees. We do not wish to exclude any student for whom this fee may represent a financial hardship. If this is the case, please speak with your principal, who will work with us to arrange assistance.

Please be sure that your child returns the attached Permission Slip/Registration Form to your school's music teacher by November 5, 2014 together with your check in the amount of \$20.00, made payable to Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS). Registration is not complete until both items have been returned. *Include your child's full name on the line in the lower left hand corner of your check*.

We hope you will support your child's opportunity to work together with other students at this high level of musical endeavor.
