French Immersion programs do not utilize a single textbook as their foundation. Instead, instruction is guided by the Common Core State Standards, which serve as the framework for curriculum design and instructional planning. This approach allows teachers to integrate authentic resources, literary works, and a variety of instructional materials that support both language acquisition and content mastery. By focusing on standards and adapting resources to meet the linguistic needs of their students, rather than using a prescribed text, students develop the critical thinking, communication, and problem-solving skills necessary for academic success while advancing their proficiency in French.

Students explore solids, liquids, and gases and investigate characteristics like color, size, and texture. They learn how the properties of materials determine how they are used and apply this knowledge by designing and testing a playground structure that can withstand heavy use and rain.
