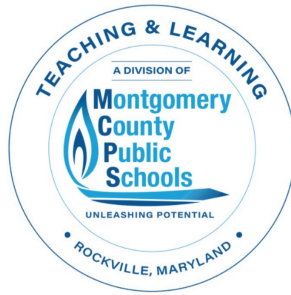
Science

What is Weather?

In this unit, students explore weather by making daily observations and noticing patterns in sunlight, rain, wind, and snow. They learn how weather affects our lives and how scientists predict it to keep us safe. Students also use their knowledge to design and test small structures, like shade shelters and roofs, to protect from sun and rain.

- **Key terms:** weather, sunlight, temperature, wind, rain, snow, heat, observation, pattern, forecast, engineer, shelter
