Maryland Public Secondary Schools Athletic Association (MPSSAA) fall interscholastic athletic teams may begin practices on Wednesday, August 14, 2024. Though it is not mandatory that fall teams begin practice on August 14, all teams must begin practices by Saturday, August 17, 2024. Teams may distribute equipment on Tuesday, August 13, 2024.
