**OPTION 1 "L" SCHEME**




**OPTION 2 "BAR" SCHEME**


# Work Session 2

- New school building is located at the NW corner of the site near the corner of Fields Road and Morrison Drive.
- Access to parent drop-off loop and visitor/teacher/student parking lots occurs only from Fields Road.
- Access to bus loop and service/delivery area occurs only from Omega Drive.
- Prominent, accessible location of main entrance, gymnasium, and auditorium (AUD).
- Parking lots adjacent to school and stadium.
- Strong pedestrian connection(s) to community.
- Principles of New Urbanism Design (walkable, sustainable, sense of place, etc.)




# The Preferred Concept: Option 1

## Strengths:

- Building has strong presence at the NW corner of the site.
- Building form shields parking from the community edge along Morrison Drive, while engaging community with “gateway” at Vermeer Ave.
- Masterplan addition provides opportunity for increased (building) presence on Fields Road.
- Increased parking count for staff on south side.

## Refinements:

- Explore locating courts closer to community
- Study building interior program
- Study exterior building massing.









# Summary


- New school building is located at the NW corner of the site near the corner of Fields Road and Morrison Drive.
- Prominent, accessible location of main entrance, gymnasium, and auditorium (AUD).
- Access to parent drop-off loop and visitor + student parking lots occurs from Fields Road and Omega Drive.
- Access to staff parking lot occurs from Omega Drive.
- Access to bus loop and service/delivery area occurs only from Omega Drive.
- Stadium complex located at highest portion of the site, near Omega Drive.
- Baseball and Softball fields at lowest portion of the site, near forest conservation area (Zone C).
- Courts located adjacent to bus drop off near Morrison Drive.
- Parking lots adjacent to school and stadium.
- Strong pedestrian connection(s) to community.
