Green Things

Commit to three classroom actions, assign the roles to students, and help your school save energy and increase recycling participation.

Assigning the roles described below will help us save the environment and keep within our MCPS budget while providing leadership opportunities for our students. Help teach students that their actions make a difference!



Assign a student to make sure all lights are turned off each time the class exits the room.

Light Leader

Assign a student to make sure classroom doors are closed. This helps maintain proper temperatures and reduces our energy costs. See the <u>flyer</u> about closing windows and doors.

Door Diplomat

Assign a student to monitor the recycling and trash bins to make sure everyone is using them properly.

Recycling Ranger

Assign a student to close the windows and blinds at the end of the day. See the flyer about closing blinds.

Window Watcher Assign a student to announce an energy or recycing fun fact to the class each morning. Awareness helps MCPS save energy systemwide!

Fact Finder

Assign a student to shut down classroom computers at the end of the school day.
