



# Process for Recycling Award Identification

### **PURPOSE:**

This process was developed to determine which Montgomery County Public Schools should receive a quarterly SERT recycling award.

#### **PROCESS SUMMARY:**

- 1. The process begins when quarterly recycling data has been investigated and approved by the SERT recycling manager.
- 2. School quarterly recycling data is compared to improvement over the baseline data set by the SERT program.
- 3. SERT staff submit recommendations of schools that have demonstrated best management practices during the quarter to increase recycling awareness and participation.
- 4. The SERT recycling manager reviews and confirms data and generates a list of schools that are eligible for the award.
- 5. The recycling manager submits the list of winning schools to the SERT program manager for review and final approval.
- 6. Upon approval by the SERT program manager, the recycling manager submits the award winners list to the information specialist to process the transfer of award funds.
- 7. The SERT program technician creates award certificates for distribution and publishes the list of winning schools in SERT Spotlight and on the website.
- 8. The recycling manager and recycling technician distribute award certificates to winning schools.

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

SERT recycling awards are given to schools that meet the recycling goals set by the SERT program. All best management practices and recycling data for each school during each quarter are taken into consideration to determine the winning schools.
