

ESOL Postbaccalaureate Certificate for MCPS English Teachers

The ESOL post-baccalaureate certificate (PBC) program provides foundational professional development for P-12 teachers working with English learners. The ESOL PBC also prepares teachers to add an ESOL endorsement to their certification by passing the state-mandated Praxis exams.

Courses

Courses are taught online in an asynchronous format that allows professionals to balance their studies with work and family.

Tuition: \$162 per credit (\$486 per course)

Technology fee: \$16 per credit (\$48 per course)

One-time Fees

Matriculation fee: \$200 (divided over two terms)

Graduation application fee: \$35 (final term)
