  - Reopen Woodward High School to address space issues at Walter Johnson High School and other high school including:


Bethesda-Chevy Chase HS Northwood HS

#### Master/Sector Plans

- Residential development is tracked by MCPS
- Master and sector plans will be included in the study
- Study group will be provided long-term projections for each high school that will include future residential development

#### **Possible Timeline**

- Earliest Woodward HS can reopen is September 2022
  - o Tilden MS will move to new location in September 2020
  - o Construction takes at least two years for a new high school
- No boundary changes would occur prior to this time
- Boundary studies occur 18 months prior to a school opening or construction project
- Current Grade 5 students could possibly be impacted by the proposed reopening of the school

### **DCC Capacity Study**

- Study possible additions to four high schools
   How large can they be expanded
- Earliest that additions could open—September 2022
- No student reassignments, if any would occur prior to the opening of additions
- Boundary studies would occur 18 months prior to opening of additions
