



MCPS Pre-K – 12 Student Enrollment


MCPS enrollment is on the rise again after the pandemic.




Stabilizing Literacy for All Students

Reading by Grade 3 is rebounding after the pandemic




Middle School Math / MCPS compared to the State of Maryland


MCPS outperformed the state on algebra 1 and geometry tests, and underperformed state on math 8.

Four-Year Adjusted Graduation Rate (By Race)


MCPS Graduation Rate Has Remained Strong Throughout the Pandemic (With Key Gains for African-American and Hispanic/Latino Students)



Four-Year Adjusted Graduation Rate (By Services Received)




MCPS and Maryland Graduation Rate

MCPS graduation rate continues to exceed the state.




AP Access: Exams Taken (by Race/Ethnicity)

Students are increasing their participation in Advanced Placement assessment.




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


AP Exam Performance – 3 or Higher (By Race/Ethnicity) AP Exam Performance has returned to pre-pandemic levels.




AP Exam Performance – 3 or Higher (by Services Received)



Career and Technical Education (CTE) Concentrators More Students Are Pursuing CTE Pathways




Dual Enrollment Access

More MCPS students are accessing college coursework during high school.




Immediate College Enrollment After High School by Race/Ethnicity

FY 2024 Accelerator Highlights Innovation / Acceleration / Support

Proposed FY 2024 Budget includes \$47M in accelerators to support the diverse and growing needs of our students, while rebounding from the effects of the pandemic.

Early Childhood Education, \$2.1M

Expand Pre-K and provide additional inclusive classrooms for children with disabilities. Early childhood education programs are foundational for Kindergarten-readiness.

Dual Language Schools, \$591K

Bring dual language programs to 3 additional schools, 2 in Spanish and 1 in Chinese. Learning in dual languages is a proven approach to get all students on grade level and close disparities in learning.

Innovative Calendar Schools, \$2.5M

Establish 2 additional year-round schools for increased instructional time and engagement in at-risk communities. System is seeing consistent gains in math performance among Hispanic students in our year-round programs.

Expanding IB Programs, \$317K

Bring International Baccalaureate Program across all levels, including Middle Years Programme, to more schools. Allows students to engage in critical thinking and learn a second language.

College & Career Readiness, \$5.2M

\$3.4M to remove all costs for AP and IB exams so this expense is not a barrier. **\$1.8M** to expand CollegeTracks to 5 more high schools, to provide help to students navigating the college application process.

Support Resources, \$24.8M

\$5M for tutoring services. **\$1.5M** for bus tracking app. **\$14M** for technology support. **\$1.1M** for resource support for children with disabilities. **\$3.2M** for transportation and facilities management.
