How to Add Google Absence Form Embed Code

Log into Episerver

1. Open the Google Absence Form you want to embed.
2. Make sure you have edit access to the form.
3. Click the : More (three dots) in the top right
4. Select **Embed HTML**
5. A popup will appear. Adjust the width and height if needed and click **Copy**.
(You will paste this code into the Epi editor in a later step)



6. Go to the Login page:

7. Enter your user name and password
8. Click **Log In**



Locate Your Existing Absence Form Page


1. In the browser, go to your school's absence form page ([see list of existing Wufoo form absence pages](#)).
2. Click the orange **epi** button at the top-right corner and select **CMS Edit**.



3. Select the button on the left for **On-Page Editing**.



4. Click in the *Main Body* area where you see the old absence form.
5. The Epi editor should appear. Click the \leftrightarrow icon from the menu as shown below to switch to code view.
