
How to Add Twitter to Your Site

How to add a Twitter 'Follow' button or Embedded User Timeline to your site



A. How to add a Twitter 'Follow' button to your site



To insert a 'Follow' button:

- 1. In Tron, select the content block to which you want to add the Twitter Button and click "Edit".
- 1. Once you are in the *content work area*, click on the Code View "<>" option at the bottom



2. Once in *Code View*, copy and paste the following code, and then change the two references to "WatersLandingES" to your own Twitter handle.

Follow @WatersLandingES<script async="true" src="https://platform.twitter.com/widgets.js" charset="utf-8" type="text/javascript"></script>

3. Click the "Publish" button. Your button should look like this:



B. How to embed a Twitter User Timeline on your site

- 1. In Tron, select the content block to which you want to add the User Timeline and click "Edit".
- 2. Once you are in the *content work area*, click on the Code View "<>" option at the bottom of the screen.



3. Once in *Code View*, copy and paste the following code, and change any references to WatersLandingES to your own Twitter handle.

4. Click the "Publish" button. Your timeline should look like this:



C. How to add Customization to Your Twitter Timeline

1. Go to https://publish.twitter.com/# and follow the prompts to customize your timeline and then follow the steps above to copy and paste the generated embed code into the Tron editor.
