









Remind, ParentSquare, ParentVUE—

What's the Difference?

Let's clear some things up.

We know families sometimes hear about Remind, ParentSquare, and ParentVUE and wonder—AREN'T THESE ALL THE SAME THING? The short answer: NO.

Each serves a different purpose. Here are a few questions and, importantly, answers to help you understand what each platform does, how they connect you to your child's school, and where to go for the information you need most.

What is Remind and ParentSquare?

Remind and ParentSquare is a messaging platform that is used to communicate among MCPS schools, teachers, students and parents.

Why are there two communication platforms in use?

ParentSquare acquired Remind. Schools will be in the process of transitioning from Remind to ParentSquare by January 2026.

How do I enroll or register for Remind or ParentSquare for my child's school?

Your school will provide communication on how to begin using Remind or ParentSquare.

What is ParentVUE and MyMCPS Classroom?

ParentVUE is the Parent Portal that serves as the **primary** home-to-school communication vehicle for schools to share information regarding grades, attendance, scheduling, access into myMCPS Classroom, and more. ParentVUE is accessible from a website or mobile device app.

What is MCPS MyClassroom (Canvas)?

This is the learning management system or digital learning platform that teachers can use for course management, grading, feedback, assignments, and collaboration. Parents may use an "observer" account where they can view instructional information and resources. Click here for more information.

Where do I find my official child's schedule?

Login to ParentVUE. Select your child. Click on CURRENT SCHEDULE.

What happens if I don't see my child's schedule?

Call your child's school. ParentVUE is updated in real-time.
