AB Rotation Information

Beginning with Phase 1.2 some students will experience an A/B Rotation Experience

4 days per week, A/B Rotation (½ the students in-person every other week. Every other week is virtual instruction) Customized and interconnected with the individual student's schedule of classes

IMPORTANT POINTS

- Secondary schools programming and the application of an in-person/virtual model will remain fluid as more students are able to return to in-person learning.
- Appointments: Options for secondary students, including students enrolled in Career & Technical Education Programs, Career Readiness Education Academy (CREA), Multidisciplinary Educational Training and Supports Program (METS) and Alternative Programs
- *Specials and electives will remain virtual for secondary schools. (Reason: Rooms dedicated to specials and electives will be needed for general education in order to appropriately physically distance students in buildings.)
