Arrival Traffic Pattern Reminders

During morning arrival, please do NOT pull into the bus loop to drop off. Student drop off is over by the cafeteria door. To help traffic flow better, we often allow cars to go through the bus loop and around to the traffic light to wait. Please ONLY do this if a staff member is present OR if the 3 orange cones have been placed out. It is important that we do not interfere with the flow of traffic for the buses and we keep the entrance to the bus loop OPEN at all times. Please be mindful at the stop sign, that we have staff members that come in and park in the bus loop.
