Process for identifying students as Gifted and Talented.

Why: Our school is in the process of gathering information about Grade 2 students to help make appropriate instructional program recommendations for the upcoming school year, including screening for Gifted and Talented (GT) identification. This process is referred to as SIPPI, which stands for Student Instructional Program Planning and Implementation. In December, all Grade 2 students in Montgomery County Public Schools will be assessed. You will have the opportunity to complete a parent survey in February and be part of the process.
