Did you know your student will have access to an on-line reading library?

MyOn Reader is an on-line digital library which was purchased by our PTA for our students. Our children will have access to over 10,000 books online anytime and anywhere. Students may choose to have the text read to them or read the books independently. A variety of genres are available at many different levels on many topics. The library is designed for K-12 so monitor your child to make sure they are reading books that are appropriate.

Teachers are able to use MyOn in multiple ways. It can be used during whole/small group or independent reading lessons. Teachers have the ability to assign books to students and monitor their reading progress. The collection is also being used for research projects.

Students will be able to access MyOn on most devices with WI-FI access. Students will log into their account using their student I.D. number and the password they use to log in to computers at school. We are in the process of working with MyOn to get the program up and running.
