Practice tests are available here for students to familiarize themselves with the items and formats used for the different MCAP assessments. English/Language Arts:

Grade 5 - May 13 and 14

Mathematics:

Grades 3 & 4 - May 5 and 7

- Be on time on the day of testing Students who arrive at school late will not be allowed into the classroom during a testing session and will be required to test on a make-up day.
