Grading and Homework Policies

Grading and Reporting System

Academic grades will reflect how well students have met grade level standards through a variety of tasks and activities. Participation and effort will not be included in these grades. They will be reflected in a separate section of the report card in the teaching and academic success skills area. Some work and assignments will be assessed and included in final grades. Other work will be completed for practice and will not be graded, but will contribute to teaching and academic success skills grades.

Grading

The following is a summary of how students will be evaluated. Students in grades 1, 2, and 3 will receive **ES, P, I and N** in academic subjects.

A separate section will report Learning Skills, replacing the Work Study Skills.

Teachers will use a rubric and letter code to report trends over time in these areas.

The following code will be used to report Learning Skills

- I** The student achieves the goal independently.
- L** The student achieves the goal with limited prompting from the teacher.
- F** The student achieves the goal with frequent prompting from the teacher
- R** The student rarely achieves the goal.
- NI** Not enough information.
