#### **Mission**





# How can YOU help your child be successful in math?

- Practice rote counting to 100
- Practice counting to 31 with 1 to 1 correspondence
- Practice writing numbers to 20
- Practice identifying numbers to 20
- Practice identifying shapes and colors
- Practice positional words

# How can YOU help your child be successful in English Language Arts (ELA)?

- Practice writing first <u>and</u> last name
- Identify letter sounds
- Identify upper and lower case letters
- Read with your child for 20 minutes every night
- If your child is writing already, practice writing a sentence ending with a punctuation mark (.?!)

# Self Help Skills to Practice Independence

- Tying shoes
- Zipping your coat, backpack, lunchbox
- Buttoning and zipping pants
- Bathroom independence
- Recognizing name
- Opening food/drink containers
- Following directions from adults



#### **Required Testing Fall**

#### September/October

- DIBELS (Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills)
   K-2
- MAP-P (Measures of Academic Progress Primary) K-2
- EUREKA assessments throughout the school year.
- CKLA assessments related to reading & writing
- KRA (Kindergarten Readiness Assessment)

DIBELS and MAP-P assessments will occur again in the winter and spring.



#### **Start time**

Our doors open at 9:15 AM, please ensure you arrive on time for your child to successfully unpack to start learning on time.

9:25 AM is when students should be seated and ready to learn

#### **Breakfast**

Students may pick up breakfast at the cafeteria when they arrive and eat it in their classroom.


#### **Arrival Procedures**

#### Kiss & Ride

- Open 9:15 9:25 A.M. The entrance to our lot closes promptly at 9:25
- If you arrive after 9:25, you must park and walk your child into the office to sign them in for a late pass.
- Remember that it is only a right turn into our lot and right turn out. Do not stop on Yale Place between our lot and bus loop entrance to let your child exit the car.


#### **Walking to School**

#### **End time**

3:50 P.M. is the end of our instructional school day

<u>Independent walkers</u> will exit out of our classroom exit doors. Families will meet students at their respective classroom doors.

- Barrett and Dias DOOR 10 & Tubiolo, DOOR 9
- If you have not picked up your child by 3:55 P.M., they will be taken to the main office to call home and wait for you there.
- If your child is taking the bus home, be sure that you are present at the bus stop before the bus arrives.
- The bus drivers are permitted to leave all students <u>which</u> <u>includes kindergarten students</u> at the bus stop without an adult being present.

#### **Breakfast and Lunch**






## **Online School Payments**

# First Week of School CGES Kindergarten Switcheroo

#### **How it Works:**

- First day of school students will stay with their homeroom teacher.
- On Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday students will spend time in different kindergarten classrooms.
- Permanent classes will be made on Thursday, August 28th after school.
- An email will be sent home Thursday evening letting you know who your child's teacher will be for the remainder of the school year.
- Children will report to their permanent teacher classroom on Friday, August 29th.



#### **Communication Folders**

 Check and send your child's green folder to school every day.

#### **Keeping in Contact**

- Use the email address from the school website or provided by your child's teacher (@mcpsmd.org).
- Understanding that time is limited and valued. You should receive a response to emails within 2 days. Please send us another email if you don't hear from us...sometimes we make mistakes!

#### Frequently Asked Questions

- Breakfast: Your child can buy breakfast at school and eat it in their classrooms.
- Lunch: Your child can bring a lunch box (labeled), or buy lunch at school. Students eat lunch in the All Purpose Room
- Snack: please send an individual snack (separate from lunchbox), so your child can eat it during the afternoon. (crackers, grapes, apples, etc). No glass containers, please.
- Feel free to send a refillable water bottle with your child.
   We have water fountains in our classroom.
- Please no juice boxes or fruit cups

#### **Frequently Asked Questions**

- Extra set of clothing labeled with your child's name in a bag (accidents can happen!)
- A labeled water bottle for your child (NO GLASS).
- School supplies labeled with your child's name. Please send them during the second week of school (September 2nd).
