	Reading	Students will identify the main idea of a book and make inferences about a topic. We will also recognize words with target beginning/ending sounds.
ST. S	Writing	Students will add details to drawings and dictate a sentence or story about plants and butterflies. Students will also continue to print uppercase and lowercase letters.
2 + 2	Math	Students will reason if there are enough, more than, less than, or the same number of objects in a set using matching and counting strategies. Students will also focus on identifying first and last in quantities up to 5 and 10 in different configurations
	Science	Students will describe and compare seeds and plants. Students will also discuss how light from sun affects people, animals and plants.
	Social Studies	Students will discuss ways to prevent pollution and the importance of recycling and how to do it.
