	Home Volunteers : Helps to prepare materials at home and sends them in with their child (i.e., teacher send home materials to be assembled, cut, or glued and return to school).
	Recess Volunteers: Helps facilitate recess games (indoor/outdoor) and interact with our students.
	Classroom Volunteers : Helps work with students in the classroom (i.e., listening to students read helping with basic math facts, working with small groups, etc.).
	Field Trip Volunteers: Helps to chaperone during field trips.

Please note: All MCPS volunteers are required to complete mandatory training in the prevention, recognition, and reporting of child abuse and neglect.

Volunteer Requirements

All MCPS volunteers and contractors are required to complete mandatory training in the prevention, recognition, and reporting of child abuse and neglect.

- The module is available on the MCPS Child Abuse and Neglect webpage.
- Online training videos are available in English and 5 other languages
- Volunteers should print verification e-mail that they receive upon completion of the training and present it to the school at which they wish to volunteer.
- Volunteers may not interact with students until the training has been completed and verified by school staff members.
- The school's volunteer liaison should keep a copy of all volunteer training verification e-mails.

Beginning 2017-2018 school year, volunteers will need to complete the child abuse and neglect training at least once every three years to continue volunteering.

If volunteering training was taken in:

- ✓ 2016-2017 renew in 2020-2021
- ✓ 2017-2018 renew in 2020-2021
- ✓ 2018-2019 renew in 2021-2022

The following MCPS volunteers are required to undergo fingerprinting and background checks:

- Volunteer coaches;
- Overnight chaperones for the Outdoor Environmental Education Programs (OEEP);
- Overnight field trip chaperones;
- Volunteers on field trips that require approval from the Office of School Support and Improvement (OSSI); and
- Volunteers with unsupervised, direct access to students.
