This Week's Focus

Reading-

- We will work on Units 6 and 7 of our new ELA curriculum.
- The Unit 6 focus will be on how stories teach many lessons. The question that students will answer is, "what can we learn from a mistake?"
 - o Students will focus on identifying the central message or lesson of the story using key details (RL.1.2)
- The Unit 7 focus will be on past, present, and future. The question that students will answer is, "why is the past important?"
 - o Students will focus on identifying key details from the text, photographs, and text features (RI.1.5 and RI.1.6).

Math-

We will focus on using addition and subtraction within 20 to solve various types of word problems. Students will use strategies such as using objects, drawings, and writing equations to solve (1.OA.A.1).

Social Studies-

We will use geographic tools to locate and describe places on Earth.

Science-

We will learn how animal and plant parents protect their offspring so they can survive. We will then transfer our learning into creating a bird nest for a bird offspring.
