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This Week's Focus

Reading-

We will work on Unit 3 of our new ELA curriculum. The focus will be on how plants and animals can change. The question that students will answer is "why do living things change?"

Students will focus on identifying key details from the text, pictures/photographs, and text features (RI.1.2, RI.1.5, and RI.1.7)

Math-

We will focus on using addition and subtraction within 20 to solve various types of word problems. Students will use strategies such as using objects, drawings, and writing equations to solve (1.OA.A.1).

Social Studies-

We will find differences between the past and the present by comparing people and objects.

Science-

Students will learn how light, sound, and movement can be used to send messages. They will demonstrate their learning by creating their own messaging device in small groups.
