-Graphing, collecting data through surveys, sorting objects, explaining how we sort, making tally marks, interpreting the data, utilizing the data to make bar graphs, pictographs, interpreting the bar graph Ex; How many had the most, least, altogether, How many more _____ than __ -Understanding base ten place value and modeling it, writing it in expanded notation, standard form, and adding and subtracting -Solving addition and subtraction word problems; and add and subtract within 10, e.g. by using objects or drawings to represent the problem -Decomposing numbers less than or equal to 10 into pairs in more than one way; e.g. by using by using objects or drawings and recording 'each decomposition by an equation or drawing 9 (e.g. 5=2+3 or 2+3=5)
