Math Focus

This month, we will continue to work within Module 1 of the Eureka curriculum. First graders will make significant progress toward fluency with addition and subtraction of numbers to 10 (**1.0A.C.6**) as they are presented with opportunities intended to advance them from *counting all* to *counting on*, which leads many students then to decomposing and composing addends and total amounts.

Reading and Writing Focus
