Math Focus

We will be starting our Geometry module in Eureka this month (Module 5). We will be looking at identifying the attributes of two-dimensional and three-dimensional shapes, composing varied shapes and using those shapes to create new shapes, and partitioning shapes (circle and rectangle) into two and four equal shares. Finally, we will be learning to tell and write time to the hour and half hour using both digital and analog clocks.

Reading and Writing Focus

Knowledge: We will begin Domain 8, which concentrates on the wonders of the natural world through animals and habitats and their interconnectedness. There will be exploration of diverse ecosystems, adaptation, interdependence, and different water habitats (saltwater/freshwater).

Skills: We will continue through Skills 5, where students will begin exploring spelling alternatives, plural endings, root words and spelling changes. Students will continue to complete spelling assessments and read and answer comprehension questions from a new decodable. First grade will continue to use the writing process by writing letters and opinion pieces throughout the unit.

Science and Social Studies Focus

Starting the Month off with **Health**, we will be focusing on Family Life. Students will explore the many beautiful ways families are structured, identifying what makes every family special. We will also look at the relationship of height and weight to the human growth process and what factors can affect growth.

In **Social Studies**, we are becoming community experts! We'll be investigating the jobs in our community. Students will see how everyone works together to support a thriving community with the different resources needed for each job.
