Math Focus

In math we have begun Module 1 of Eureka. Module 1 focuses on building students' fluency with addition and introduces multiplication and division. We have been solving multiplication and division using a variety of strategies. Some strategies include repeated addition, equal groups, arrays, number bonds and skip counting. The module wraps up with analyzing the relationship between multiplication and division. See below for parent tip sheets.

Reading and Writing Focus

In reading we are starting unit 1 of our new CKLA curriculum. We will learn about the elements of fictional narratives, including dialogue, narration, characters, plot, and setting. They will be exposed to rich language and a variety of vocabulary and will discuss literature with their teacher and classmates. Students will be guided through a variety of writing experiences focused on different purposes for their writing. They will also collaborate with their classmates and share their ideas as they develop and deepen their understanding of these literacy skills.

We will also be starting unit 2 where students will have the opportunity to engage in discussions with their teacher and classmates, in which they will be asked to respond based on observations and thinking that occurred throughout their reading. Students will focus on an informational writing piece that will extend their understanding of animal classification. They will also have many opportunities to work with their peers, share ideas, and provide feedback on their writing.

Science and Social Studies Focus

We are starting the year off with health where we will learn and analyze decision making skills, self regulation of emotions, and go over components of well being. As the month progresses, we will dive into our first social studies unit which covers how and why people make financial decisions.
