#### Math Focus

We are wrapping up Module 2 where students will explore measurement using units of kilograms, grams, liters, milliliters, and intervals of time in minutes. Then we will begin Module 3, which builds directly on students' work with multiplication and division in Module 1. Module 3 extends the study of factors from 2, 3, 4, 5, and 10 to include all units from 0 to 10, as well as multiples of 10 within 100.

### Reading and Writing Focus

We will be finishing up Unit 3 where we are learning about the skeletal, muscular, and nervous systems that make up our bodies.

We have further explored the senses of sight and hearing and how our eyes and ears work. We will also write about one of the body systems they have studied in this unit.

We will also be starting Unit 4 this month. Students will learn about Roman geography and history, government, major leaders, and

monumental battles. They will also study the rise and decline of the Roman Empire. Students will be introduced to a writing portfolio, which they will reference as they collaborate, share ideas, and give feedback on their writing.

#### Science and Social Studies Focus

We will be doing Social Studies during the month of November. Students will use social studies literacy and thinking skills to explore what it means to live and be involved in a democracy. They will answer the unit question: How can we make a difference in our community? More specifically, they will look at what a democracy looks like in the U.S., what virtues are important for living together in a democracy, and how they can contribute to their community.
