Learning Focus

Eureka Math

During the month of March we will continue working on Module 4. Students will practice decomposing numbers up to 8 by breaking off a part, hiding a part, and crossing off a part. The end of our month will focus on addition with totals of 9 and 10. Then we will transition to subtraction from 9 and 10. Throughout this module students will master vocabulary including addition, subtraction, plus, minus, take away, whole, part, number bond, and number pairs/ partners.

Learning Focus Continued

CKLA Reading

In Skills Unit 7 students will learn consonant digraphs /ch/, /sh/, /th/, /qu/, /ng/. We are learning "tricky" words: down, of, out. Students are working on reading decodable stories. Please have them show you what they are learning and practice with the Skills papers they take home daily.

In Knowledge unit 7, students will begin to learn about the responsibilities, customs, and lifestyles of kings and queens. Students will identify advantages and disadvantages of being royal. Students will identify story elements, write a sentence about a king, and compare their family to a royal family. Towards the end of March, we will begin our next Knowledge domain on seasons and weather.

NGSS Science

In science, students will conduct an investigation of how different pushes and pulls (forces) can make an object move faster or slower. Students will apply their understanding of force and motion by designing a device to change the motion of a rolling ball. Students will explore how different types of surfaces may also change motion. Finally, students will apply their understanding to refine the design of a trap to catch an object!

Health

Students will work on building critical thinking skills by synthesizing the dynamics of a family. We will define a family, label family members, and explain position in family structure.
