Learning Focus

Math: This month, we will continue to work within Module 1 of the Eureka curriculum. We will make significant progress towards fluency between numbers zero through ten. Our focus will be on counting, identifying a five group within a group of 6 or more, and identifying one more or one less.

Learning Focus Continued

Science: We will be exploring earth, space, and physical science. Students will identify practices of scientists and engineers. In addition, we will make simple observations of the weather using our senses, as well as, plan and conduct investigations to test the effects of sunlight on different colors.

Learning Focus Continued

Language Arts: We will continue diving into the second half of Unit 1 - Benchmark Advance curriculum. Our essential question is "Why do we have rules?" In this unit, students read and compare selections about rules at school and at home to learn about responsibility. Through the shared writing process we will write key details, rules, narratives, opinions, and comparisons. Using our Really Great Reading program for explicit phonics instruction, we are focusing on isolating the beginning sounds in words by using pictures and listening to the sound. By the end of October, we will focus on letter names and stretching sounds.
