Math- We will be completing Module 3 of Eureka Math with topics E, F, G, and H. Students will be identifying and creating a set of more, less and equal amounts, as well as, comparing sets and numerals. We will compare numerals using materials and answering questions such as, "Which set has more cubes?" and "Which set has fewer objects?" We will emphasize using units to show the comparison. They will be using language such as, **more/less than**.

LEARNING FOCUS CONTINUED

Language Arts-

In January we revisit our rules and routines. We review our Unit 3 essential question, "What do plants and animals need to survive?" and take the Interim 3 assessment. At the end of January we begin module 4 with fiction text. Unit 4's essential question is "Why do people tell stories?" In this unit, students read and compare stories to understand the purpose of storytelling. We retell key events including characters, setting, problem and solution.

Health- At the end of January, we learn about safety and injury prevention, including how to get help in an emergency.

Science- Students finish analyzing weather to answer the question, "Does our weather stay the same or change?" They learn how to stay safe in severe weather.
