## Eureka Math Summer Activity Ideas

- Count verbally to 20 by ones.
- Compare 2 groups of objects up to 5 and then 10 . Identify whether the number of objects in one group is more/greater, less/fewer, or same/equal to another group of objects. For example, a group of 4 seashells is more/greater than a group of 2 seashells.
- Represent a number 0-5 and then up to 10 using objects, pictures, and numerals. For example, create a set of 5 legos and write the numeral 5 to answer how many legos.



## Summer Reading Ideas

- Read aloud with your child every day.
- Identify story parts in fiction stories: setting, character(s), sequence of events, problem, and solution.
- Identify picture clues in the story
For example, I think the boy is mad because his arms are crossed and he is frowning in the picture.


## Summer Writing Ideas

- Have your child write their first name on all their artwork. Can they write their last name too?
- Create dictated drawing experiences for your child.
For example, an adult or older sibling can model how to draw a playground scene. Then the child copy and complete each step the adult created in their drawing.
