### Eureka Math

- Students will learn to describe the measurable attributes of objects as tall, short, long, heavy, light, big, and small.
- Students will use the language of comparison - for example *-taller than, shorter than, about the same as* when comparing the measurable attributes of two objects.
- Students will compare sets of objects up to 5 using statements to describe them - for example- "There are more bears than chairs."
- Students will compare sets including numerals up to 5 using statements - for example- "5 is greater than 3. 3 is less than 5."



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### CKLA Reading

We have really enjoyed learning about plants and growing seeds, and we will continue learning more about plants in the coming weeks. We will be talking about flowers and learning about flowers you can eat, like broccoli and cauliflower.

### CKLA Reading Continued:

Your child may come home talking about the three things plants need to grow (nutrients from soil, water, air), and what will happen to a plant if it does not get one of those things.
