Eureka Math

- Students will learn to describe the measurable attributes of objects as tall, short, long, heavy, light, big, and small.
- Students will use the language of comparison for example -*taller than*, shorter than, about the same as when comparing the measurable attributes of two objects.
- Students will compare sets of objects up to 5 using statements to describe them for example- "There are more bears than chairs."
- Students will compare sets including numerals up to 5 using statements for example- " 5 is greater than 3. 3 is less than 5."

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Benchmark Reading

March's theme is all about transportation!

We will answer the question: How do we travel and where do we go?

We will read both real and make-believe stories to identify different ways that people travel on land, in water, and through air. We will also identify different reasons that people travel.

March Focus Letters and Sounds

We will be learning sounds and letters names: Ee, Dd, Rr

- We will be identifying the short vowel sound of letter Ee as /e/ like we hear at the beginning of the word 'egg' or 'edge.'
- We will be identifying the sound of letter Dd as /d/- like we hear at the beginning of the word 'duck' or 'dog.'
- We will be identifying the sound of letter Rr as /r/-like we hear at the beginning of the word 'rabbit.'
