

# **Meet Our School Counselor**

My name is Alicia Gottesman and I am thrilled to be starting my 10<sup>th</sup> year at Lakewood Elementary School as school counselor. Previous to becoming a counselor, I served as a 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade teacher in Montgomery County. My goal is to help all students be successful academically, socially, and emotionally. I am here as a resource to teachers, children, and families to identify, address, and mitigate challenges so that all students can thrive academically and socially. The Lakewood comprehensive counseling program includes:

#### **Classroom Guidance and Classroom Meetings**

I visit each classroom once a month to facilitate discussions and activities. Topics sometimes include expressing feelings, managing conflicts, developing growth mindset, personal body safety, career development and bullying prevention.

#### **Individual and Small Group Counseling**

Short-term individual and small group counseling may cover topics such as grief, social skills, and divorce. Referrals to the counseling office are initiated based on student, teacher, or parent concerns. Group counseling groups are run during the lunch/recess block for six week sessions.

#### **Lunch Bunches**

Lunch Bunches are used to welcome new students, help students to make and maintain friendships, and to problem solve through conflicts.

### **School-wide Programs**

This year, our students will focus on making healthy choices during our "Red Ribbon Week" in the fall. We will also be participating in a disability awareness week where we will learn about

empathy and acceptance. Finally, we have a welcome buddy program so new students can be mentored by some of our finest student leaders.
