Bus Route Schedules

After most routes are scheduled by mid-August, we anticipate displaying bus information in ParentVue/StudentVUE by Friday, August 15, 2025.

Cell Phones

In accordance with MCPS policies, students may carry cell phones to school. Students must make sure that the cell phone and smart watches are off during the school day, left in the backpack, and not used until they leave school. Please note staff cannot be responsible for phones if lost or stolen. Please review the updated <u>regulation for personal devices</u> (PMD) for more information.

MCPS Attendance Policy

Our focus on attendance is part of us getting back to "normal" after covid. We certainly do not want sick kids at school but let's work together to make sure our healthy students are here regularly.

Missing a day of school here and there may not seem like much but it adds up.

When a student misses 2 days a month, they will:

- miss 20 days a year
- miss 30 hours of math
- miss 60 hours of reading and writing
- miss over 1 year of school by graduation

When a student misses 4 days a month:

- miss 40 days a year
- miss 60 hours of math
- miss 120 hours of reading and writing
- miss over 2 years of school by graduation

Missing a few days here and there doesn't seem like a big deal, but as you can see, a few school absences add up to a lot of missed instruction! Regular attendance is vital for student success. Research shows that students with chronic absenteeism are less likely to read proficiently by third grade, achieve in middle school, or graduate from high school.

Help your child succeed academically by talking with them about the importance of school. Establish morning and evening routines making bedtime and mornings less stressful and schedule non-essential appointments and vacations outside of the school day.

Reporting an absence:

Please call or email by 9:30 am to report your child's absence. The office opens at 8:30 a.m. If you need to call prior to that time please call and leave a message on the answering machine stating your child's name and classroom teacher. OR fill out this form:

Late Arrival/Early Departure

- For any student arriving after 9:25 am, a parent/guardian must come into the building to sign the student in.
- For any student leaving prior to 3:50 pm, an email or a handwritten note should be sent to school by 9:30 am. A parent/guardian must come into the building to sign the student out.

Morning Arrival Procedures

As we continue to maintain safety as a high priority we want to inform you of our morning arrival procedures. Students continue to be expected not to arrive before 9:07 am. Doors will open at 9:07 am. If buses arrive early, students will remain on their bus until 9:07 am. We do not have supervision for your child prior to that time.

Kiss & Ride Procedures

Arrival and Pick-Up:

- All vehicles must enter the traffic circle and proceed to complete the entire round-about before stopping to drop off or pick up students.
- Parents should not stop or park in the middle of the traffic circle or parking lot.

Child Pick-Up Procedure:

- Parents should display a sign with their child's name in the front windshield when they pull up. This helps staff quickly identify the child and have them ready for pick-up.
- Staff will assist in guiding children to their cars. No child should cross the parking lot to reach a vehicle.

Parking and Walking:


- Parents who wish to walk their children into school or prefer to pick them up on foot must park in designated parking spaces in the parking lot near the gym and not by the kiss and ride.
- Parents should use the crosswalks and avoid walking through the traffic circle or parking lot during peak times.

Traffic Monitoring:

- Staff or designated volunteers will be stationed at critical points to ensure all vehicles complete the full round-about and to monitor traffic flow.
- Any vehicle that does not follow the outlined process will be politely reminded of the correct procedure.

Safety First:

• Under no circumstances should children be instructed to cross the parking lot alone. All children must wait for staff assistance to ensure their safety.



Student Safety and Dismissal

For the safety of all North Chevy Chase students, please send a note to your child's teacher if he/she is going to an after school program or home with a friend. A note or email is required for any changes to a student's normal dismissal.

- In the interest of safety, students unsure of their after school plans should notify their teacher or the school office as soon as possible. Once a student has raised a concern regarding their after school plans, or a school official has detected one, the school will attempt to contact the student's parent or guardian to confirm the after school arrangements. If contact cannot be made, the student may be required to remain at the school until a responsible adult can be reached.
- A student without a note who does not let staff know they have different dismissal plans will be sent home on their regular bus or to walk home as they normally do. So please have a plan for what your child should do if they get home or off of the bus and their trusted adult is not there. Will they stay on the bus? Ask another parent to call? Do they know their adult's phone number? Will they go to a trusted neighbor's house?

Toys

Please do not allow your child to bring any toys, trading cards, and/or electronic games items to school. Items such as these interfere with the educational program and are not a benefit to your child's learning.

Here's what you need to know:

• Who Attends: *Only students entering 3rd grade*

- Purpose: Students will tour the building, meet staff, learn routines, and get a head start building relationships in a calm, supportive environment.
- KAH (Kids After Hours): KAH will be open for registered third grade families on this day, operating under modified hours from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.. Please reach out directly to KAH if you have questions about enrollment or availability.

This new calendar feature was adopted by the Board of Education. We are thrilled to offer this opportunity and look forward to a successful and joyful start to the school year.

Please note: This special Transition Day event is *not* to be confused with our Open House, which will still take place on Friday, August 22, from 11:00 AM to 12:00 PM for all NCC families.
