Kensington Parkwood Student Chosen as Winner for Maryland in Doodle for Google Student Contest.

A talented Kensington Maryland based student could soon have her art on the Google homepage for hundreds of millions to see. Google is announcing the 55 State and Territory winners in its Doodle for Google competition, a contest where K-12 students across the United States have the opportunity to create their own version of the Google logo inspired by the prompt “My wish for the next 25 years...”.

Sofia, a second grader from Kensington Parkwood, Kensington MD, is one of the 55 US State and Territory Winners with her Doodle. Sofia’s Doodle was selected from thousands of entries received this year. Students at Kensington Parkwood helped Sofia celebrate during a surprise assembly.

To help their favorite Doodles succeed, people across the U.S. can vote for their favorite Doodle from the 55 State and Territory Winners. Voting will be open from **May 22 - June 4** on this site: <https://doodles.google.com/d4g/> and the public vote will determine the contest finalists and winner. Google will announce these five National Finalists in late May, one of whom will have their Doodle featured on the Google homepage for a day.

The National Winner will take home a \$55,000 college scholarship and their school will receive a \$50,000 tech package towards the establishment or improvement of a computer lab or technology program.
