## \*\*\*\*\*Approved PTA 23-24 Budget Adjustments\*\*\*\*\*\*

- Revenues
  - Original Budget based on projected \$47,325 in revenues.
  - Budget Adjustments adjusts to projected revenues to a more realistic \$35k
  - Downward adjustments (total approx \$12k)
    - ReadAThon (by approximately \$5k)
    - Book Fair (\$6k) a wash because it is a budget pass thru
    - Spirit Wear/Memberships/Restaurant Nights (approx \$1k)
- Expenditures
  - Original Budget expenditures \$42,790
  - Budget Adjustments adjust expenditures to \$29,276
  - Downward adjustments (total approx \$13,500)
    - Book Fair (\$6k)
    - Category cuts
      - Meetings and Operations (\$1k)
      - Fundraising Costs (\$700 SpiritWear inventory)
      - School Support (Beautification and Recess \$1k)
      - Enrichment \$2k (new initiatives in EML conversations club and afterschool scholarships)
      - Community Building approx \$2k (Heritage Month spending significantly lower, so cut \$1,750; still leaves \$750) and there

was \$400 in savings from the amount that was budgeted for  $\ensuremath{\mathsf{BTS}}$  .

- Estimated higher carryforward of \$5,715 (vs original budget carryforward of \$4,535
- Major takeaways Grade-level priorities funding is kept whole, and staff appreciation and staff reimbursement budgets are also kept whole.
