First Day of School

The first day of school is Monday, August 30. School begins at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 3:25 p.m. Children should not arrive at school before 8:40 a.m.

Kiss and Wave

We look forward to welcoming all students back for in person learning. In an effort to help students become acclimated on the first day of school and for the safety of our students and staff, we are asking all parents to drop students off at the front of the building on the first day of school. Instead of entering the building, we ask parents to "Kiss and Wave."

Name Tags

Name tags are very important to ensure student safety. All students should wear a name tag that includes the following information.

- First and Last Name
- Grade Level and Teacher Name
- Room Number
- Phone Number
- Dismissal Plan bus color/global/car-rider

A name tag template is attached for you to print and attach to your child's backpack for the first day of school.

Cafeteria/Lunch Procedures

- All children will eat lunch in classrooms with their teacher for the first two weeks of school.
- Beginning September 13 students will eat in the cafeteria. We will implement an A/B week rotation to reduce the number of students in the cafeteria where half the grade level will eat in the cafeteria, with assigned seating, and the other half will eat in classrooms.
- All students will be supervised at all times.

- All students will participate in daily recess as normal.
- While most children will utilize the indoor lunch plan, an outdoor lunch option is available upon request. Please contact the school for more information.

PreK Students

School does not start on Monday, August 30 for PreK and CAPP students. Beginning September 8 pre-k students will begin attending school on a staggered schedule. One half of each class will start on the Wednesday September 8th, the second half will attend on Thursday September 9th and then everyone will attend on Friday September 10th.

Bus Route Changes

Due to a nationwide bus driver shortage, bus route 4112 (yellow) will make two trips beginning Tuesday, August 31. Monday, August 30, these routes will operate at the normal/published time. Beginning Tuesday, August 31, these bus routes will operate up to 30 minutes earlier than the published times so that the bus can take a second group of students, from a different set of bus stops, to your child's school. On Monday, the bus driver for each route will give students information about how much earlier the bus will run beginning Tuesday. If your bus is late or if you are uncertain about which bus your child should ride, please contact the Shady Grove North bus depot at 240-740-6220. Please check the attachment to identify your child's arrival and departure bus route, color and pick up time for the first day of school.
