<u>Curriculum Highlights</u>

Social Studies: Students will describe how consumers acquire goods/services, develop a budget, and a plan that shows how money is obtained. We will examine the production process, how choices are made because of limited natural, human, and capital resources.

Math: Module 7 begins with students solving one-step and two-step word problems using all four operations with a letter for the unknown. In Topic B, we will explore geometry in which we review concepts about polygons and their properties. They explore the attributes of quadrilaterals and classify examples into categories. Students also use tangrams and tetrominoes to compose and decompose shapes.

Science: Students will explore the phenomena of inherited traits. They will begin with an exploration of life cycles and compare animal, insect, and plant life cycles to come to the conclusion that while the stages of life may be different, all organisms grow, reproduce, and die.
