## Curriculum Highlights

Social Studies: Students will describe how consumers acquire goods/ services, develop a budget, and a plan that shows how I money is obtained. We will examine the production process, how choices are made because of limited natural, human, and capital I resources.

Math: Module 7 begins with students solving one-step and I two-step word problems using all four operations with a letter I for the unknown. In Topic B, we will explore geometry in which we I review concepts about polygons and their properties. They I explore the attributes of quadrilaterals and classify examples I into categories. Students also use tangrams and tetrominoes to compose and decompose shapes.

Science: Students will explore the phenomena of inherited traits. They will begin with an exploration of life cycles and I compare animal, insect, and plant life cycles to come to the conclusion that while the stages of life may be different, all I organisms grow, reproduce, and die.
