

If your student will be out of school around the next few school holidays, please be sure to let Mrs. Cardea, our attendance secretary, know (Sherrie H Cardea@mcpsmd.org).

For absences of ten or more days, MCPS policy states students must be unenrolled from school. Upon return, families need to submit proof of residency to the main office (Property Tax Bill or Current Lease). Every effort will be made to return the student to the classroom they left from, but enrollment is based on classroom numbers, and we cannot guarantee they'll be returned to their current classroom.

While unenrolled, students miss important class instruction. Work missed while unenrolled cannot be made up and grades will be affected.
