## The Purpose of Homework

Homework is one of the many learning activities in which students engage; its purposes should be to:

- 1. Extend learning and provide practice in applying concepts initially presented in the classroom
- 2. Provide opportunities for independent work
- 3. Strengthen concept and skill development
- 4. Provide opportunities for enrichment
- 5. Develop initiative, responsibility, self-direction and organizational skills

## **Planning and Assigning Homework**

Homework should be planned and discussed cooperatively with students to:

- a) Help students see how homework is related to classwork and instructional objectives
- b) Help students understand that homework is reviewed for completion and can be used as a data point for task completion grade
- c) Ensure that the amount of homework (3 to 5 times per week) is appropriate to students' needs and abilities and that the total homework load from all the students' teachers is a reasonable one.

<u>Suggested</u> number of minutes on task each evening for homework completion:

Grade Level	Number of Minutes on Task Daily (Mon. – Fri.)
Kindergarten	15 min. on assignments + 15 min. shared reading
First Grade	15 min. on assignments + 15 min. independent/shared reading
Second Grade	30 min. on assignments + 15 min. independent reading
Third Grade	30 min. on assignments + 20 min. independent reading
Fourth Grade	45 min. on assignments + 20 min. independent reading
Fifth Grade	45 min. on assignments + 30 min. independent reading
