Busy Bees! Check out some of the things your K student has been working on!

Reading The students are working on being able to demonstrate the understanding and basic features of print, spoken words, syllables, and sounds, and knowing phonics skills in decoding words. We have been reading books with a purpose in mind.

Writing Our students have been recalling information from experiences to answer questions and adding drawings (and other visual displays) to descriptions to provide additional details.

Math Kindergarteners have been identifying numbers and their counting sequence (by ones, by tens), counting and writing to tell the number of objects, and comparing numbers.

Science "Scientists" have been observing the weather with our five senses. We have been investigating and gathering data about the changes in weather. We are even recording our observations in weather journals.

Social Studies Why are rules important? Are you a responsible Kindergartener? We have been discussing roles, rights, and responsibilities in the classroom, in the school and at home.
