MCCPTA Report: Suzanna Files reported no meeting yet w/ WJ Cluster. She did attend Operating Budget Forum sponsored by MCCPTA. There will be significant cuts due to \$300-350 million deficit. County council will not fund Dr. Weast's requests for budget. Mr. Leventhal (County Council) recommended furlough. One reason for shortfall was snow removal. \$10million in budget, actual cost \$60 million. Wyngate Expansion isn't a done deal. What can we do? Wyngate Parents need to show up in force when Wyngate goes before board. PTA will send notices to families before meeting.
