

B-CC vs Blair 3/29

The big southern sky over Blair's lax field began a faded azure. But by the time the 2nd quarter ended it was a deep Barons blue and BCC's Laxers were well set to claim their first win of the young season. As in the first week of the season, BCC defenders gave their opposite numbers few good looks and Junior Goalie Preston Anderson was there when they got one. But the big story tonight was at the Blair's end of the field.

By the end of the fourth quarter, the entire Barons roster had seen action and Sophomore Attack Jack Dahil had put the Baron into double figures following an on-the-money pass from Senior Attack Kenyon Brady.
