**All MCPS schools will practice Distance Learning for the first semester. Students will not report to the actual building and will login to all classes, virtually.**

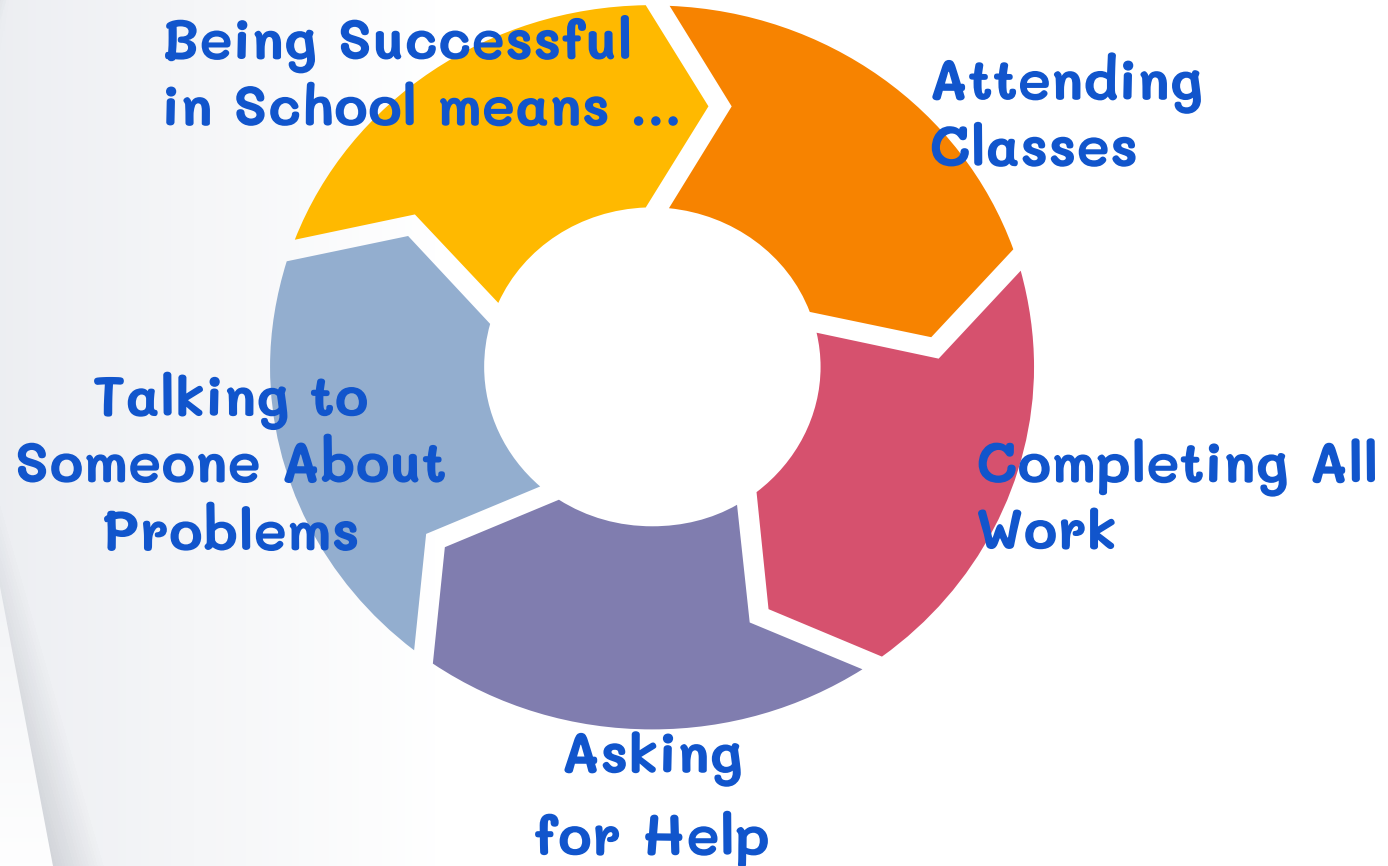

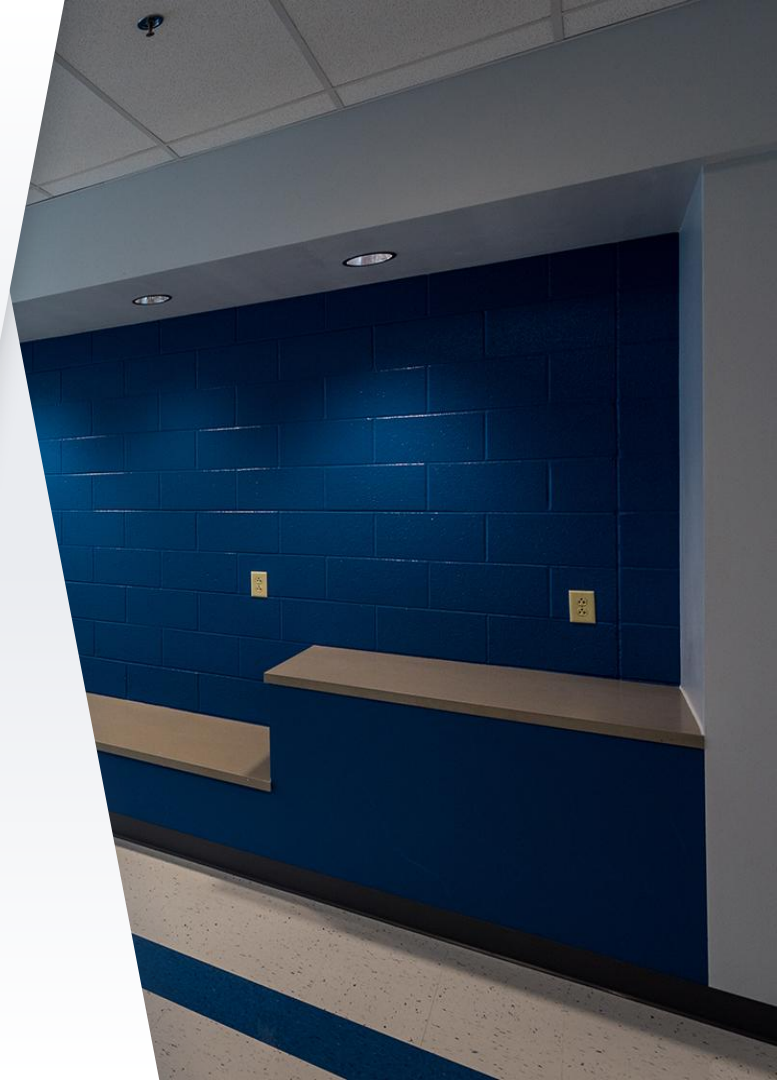
