AP Environmental Science is for highly motivated students with special interest in the relationships of the natural world. It is an interdisciplinary science that bridges aspects of biology, chemistry, and physics and applies them to real world phenomena. Students will perform in depth inquiries through laboratory investigation and case studies. Students are prepared to take the Advanced Placement Environmental Science examination. Topics on this exam and in the class focus on interrelationships of the natural world with a focus on human activities and how they impact these relationships. Students are pushed to identify problems, predict potential issues, and develop solutions.
