WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE?

- Seniors with an unweighted GPA of 2.50; Juniors with an unweighted GPA of 2.75
- Students who are at least 16 years old
- Students with qualifying test scores:
 - ✓ SAT: Evidenced Reading/Writing 480 or Reading subtest 26 and Math 530 and OR
 - ✓ ACT: Reading 21 and Math 21 OR
 - ✓ Qualifying placement from ACCUPLACER or ALEKS OR
 - ✓ APP qualifying score

WHEN AND WHERE WILL CLASSES BE HELD?

- Classes are held at BCC, taught by Montgomery College instructors
- Classes will meet two or three times a week, for a double period, during BCC's regular school day
- Fall classes begin early September and spring classes begin late January. Classes will follow MC academic calendar

WHAT CLASSES WILL BE OFFERED?

FALL 2019 - BSAD101 INTRO TO BUSINESS 3 credits

- **MATH28 MULTIVARIABLE CALCULUS** Requires AP calculus BC score of 4 or better. 4 credits, billed at 5 hours

SPRING 2020 - BSAD101 INTRO TO BUSINESS 3 credits

- **CCJS110 ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE** 3 credits
- **MATH284 LINEAR ALGEBRA** 4 credits

WHAT IS THE COST OF APPLICATION & COURSE FEES?

- There is no application fee for students who apply online to MC between Oct. 1, 2019 – Apr. 15, 2020
- MCPS students pay a reduced rate of *approximately* \$434 per one 3-credit course, per AY2019-20
- Students who qualify for financial assistance are responsible for MC fees per one 3-credit class (approximately \$137)
- All students may apply for a *MC High School Grant* to cover the cost of MC fees and textbooks

HOW DO I REGISTER FOR THE CLASS?

Student must be fully admitted by MC DE program and registered in class before the start of the course.

- Meet with your counselor to place the MC course on your high school schedule
- Contact your DEPA to start your application and registration process
- Complete MC's online application at www.montgomerycollege.edu/dep
- Submit qualifying SAT or ACT scores to MC (MC code 5440) or take the free assessments at MC
- Create account in montgomerycollege.dualenroll.com and request the MC class. It will send email messages to a parent/guardian, MCPS, and MC staff for approval
- Claim your MyMC account and complete the New Student Online Academic Orientation
- Complete the MCPS Dual Credit Refusal Form and return to your DEPA
- When you have met the DE program and course requirement, MC DE staff will enroll you
